A tool for assessing suppliers in terms of sustainability risks is currently being evaluated, which will serve as the basis for CSR audits within the framework of a responsible supply chain in the future. ESG issues are becoming increasingly important in purchasing discussions.

We promote transparency and knowledge building among stakeholders by holding information events on RAG's activities and projects. In 2023, the Neighbourhood Day was held at the Haidach site. In 2024, as part of the Ars Electronica exhibition, RAG's activities and contributions to a climate-neutral energy future were communicated with a hydrogen economic model for the future of energy. The H <sub>2</sub> Convention reached target groups such as schoolchildren, students and, above all, the population of Upper Austria. Through participation in "Teach the teacher" and other training courses, the knowledge-building objectives were achieved through lectures by RAG experts and guided tours of the RAG facilities. This open dialogue promotes a positive attitude towards RAG's projects and strengthens public understanding. The objective was thus achieved.

With the planning and implementation of the visitor path at the RAG site in Kremsmünster and the information posters about RAG Energy Valley, the path and information were made accessible to all walkers. In addition, information posters were put up at all key locations to present RAG's facilities and projects in a transparent manner. We want to increase visibility and support the population with questions and concerns through regular appearances in regional media. Several projects were specifically prepared in a multimedia format to engage and inform young people and a digitally interested public via social media.
