<b>Improvement of facility operation resilience (technical redundancies, business continuity management, restart planning)</b>		●	2023/2024	Redundancies were methodically tested and restart plans were drawn up. Business continuity management is still being implemented.
<b>Implementation of measures from the NIS audit 2022</b>		●	2023/2024	All measures with deadlines have been implemented.
<b>Reduction in the number and volume of media leaks through further development of integrity management.</b>		●	2023/2024	The focus in recent years has been on further developing pipeline integrity management and implementing the measures derived from this. In 2024, factors relating to pipeline integrity that had not previously been taken into account were also included in the risk assessment of the pipelines. A derived measurement programme (MFL pigging) and the resulting findings confirm the steps taken.
<b>Uninterrupted provision of energy supply</b>	Own power supply for production in Kremsmünster with hydrogen CHP including waste heat utilisation and photovoltaic system Krift: to ensure supply in the event of a power failure	●	2023	The hydrogen CHP plant has been built and is ready for operation. As the methane electrolysis plant is currently still in the trial phase, there is currently no continuous H <sub>2</sub> supply.
	Increase in energy storage capacities in line with market demand 2022 – 2023 Additional storage wells UGS Puchkirchen; evaluation of suitability of storage sites as hydrogen storage facilities, further storage wells UGS Nußdorf under evaluation	●	2023	In the Puchkirchen UGS area, two additional storage wells were put into operation to increase capacity.
	Restoration/renewal of radio relay links in Upper Austria for data traffic and voice radio to achieve independence from leased data lines.	●	2023	The radio relay links in Upper Austria were partially renewed, including new buildings. The work will continue until 2026.
<b>Protection of RAG Austria AG as operator of “critical infrastructure” to ensure &gt; 99.5% availability for our customers</b>	Implementation of measures and gradual upgrading to increase property protection (physical security concept)	●	2023	The requirements of the security concept were implemented at all major operating Protection of RAG Austria AG as sites and documented in a structured manner for each site in 2024.
	Further preparation for implementation of the NIS2 and RKE directives	●	2023 f.	The topic of business continuity and resilience planning was advanced by creating recovery plans and conducting various emergency tests. A GAP analysis was prepared for the additional requirements of the NIS2 Directive.
<b>Property protection</b>	Implement improvements to property protection following physical security test 2023 with businesses	●	2023	All measures have been implemented; an inspection of all key operating sites in 2024 did not result in any noteworthy complaints.
<b>Security of facilities</b>	Introduction of an OT monitoring system at the Puchkirchen storage facility in 2022, in Haidach in 2023 and in 7Fields in 2024.	●	2023	The OT monitoring system at the Puchkirchen, Haidach and 7Fields gas storage facilities is successfully in operation.
